Notes to Financial Statements Year ended December 31, 2016 (Unaudited - See Notice to Reader)

1. Nature of operations

Manyatta Network was incorporated on April 7, 2014 as a non-profit organization under the Canada Not-for-profit Corporations Act. It's vision is to bring together creative minds who seek to build a stronger professional network within the African community. The organization also organizes fund raising events to benefit community projects both loally and internationnaly.

2. Summary of significant accounting policies

The Organization applies the Canadian accounting standards for not-for-profit enterprises.

Revenue recognition

Manyatta Network follows the deferral method of accouting for contributions. Restricted contributions are recognized as revenue in the year in which the related expenses are incurred. Unrestricted contibutions are recognized as revenue when they are received or receivable if the amount to be received can be reasonably estimated and collection is reasonably assured. Endowment contributions are recognized as direct increases in net assets in the year.

Manyatta Cares event receipts are recognized as receipts when the event is held.

Cash and cash equivalents

The organization's policy is to present bank balances and term deposits with a maturity period of three months or less from the date of aquisition under cash and cash equivalents.

3. Related party transactions

A balance of \$900 (2014 - \$2,598) was due to the members of the organization as at the end of the year. This balance relates to expenses incurred on behalf of the organization. All the transactions related to these expenses were carried out in the normal course of the operations of the organization and are recorded at the cost incurred. This amount is repayable by the organization with no specila conditions or repayment terms. The amount payable bears no interest rate.

The financials statements do not conatin certain disclosures required by the Canadian accounting standards for non-for-profit organizations.
